

# Share a Flow

You can allow other users to work on flows that you own. Flow **collaborators** have almost all of the same permissions as flow **owners**.

**i** **NOTE:** Users of a shared flow must have read access to the underlying data sources to access the datasets of a shared flow. If they do not have dataset access, collaborators can still access the flow but have more limited capabilities.

## Steps:

1. In the Flows page, locate the flow to share.
2. From the context menu on the right side of the screen, select **Share...**
3. In the Share Flow dialog, click the Manage Access tab. See *Share Flow Dialog*.
4. Enter the name of the user or users with whom you would like to share the flow.
5. Click **Add**.
6. The selected users can now see the flow and interact with its objects in the Shared with Me tab of the Flows page. See *Flows Page*.
