Object Data Type

An **Object** data type is a method for encoding key-value pairs. A single field value may contain one or more sets of key-value pairs. An Object data type is identified as a set of nested objects in the following format:

```
{"key":"value"}
{"New York":"NY"}
{"California":"CA"}
```

Notes:

- Individual values of an Object type must have unique keys. Values, however, may be repeated.
- The order of key-value pairs is not guaranteed.

NOTE: The \n and \t escaped characters are supported in inputs for this data type. For more information, see *Supported Special Regular Expression Characters*.
