

Valid Data Type Strings

When referencing a data type within a transform, you can use the following strings to identify each type:

NOTE: In Wrangle transforms, these values are case-sensitive.

NOTE: When specifying a data type by name, you must use the String value listed below. The Data Type value is the display name for the type.

| Data Type | String |
|------------------------|----------------|
| String | 'String' |
| Integer | 'Integer' |
| Decimal | 'Float' |
| Boolean | 'Bool' |
| Social Security Number | 'SSN' |
| Phone Number | 'Phone' |
| Email Address | 'Emailaddress' |
| Credit Card | 'Creditcard' |
| Gender | 'Gender' |
| Object | 'Map' |
| Array | 'Array' |
| IP Address | 'Ipaddress' |
| URL | 'Url' |
| HTTP Code | 'Httpcodes' |
| Zip Code | 'Zipcode' |
| State | 'State' |
| Date / Time | 'Datetime' |
